ITINERARY

DAY 1 – TEOTIHUACÁN (OCTOBER 30, 2026)

After picking up the students at the departure points, we will begin our route to Teotihuacán.

We will arrive at our hotel in Teotihuacán, where we will enjoy our first breakfast and settle into our rooms. Afterwards, we will visit the great archaeological site of Teotihuacán, including:

- Temple of Quetzalcóatl, the great feathered serpent
- Avenue of the Dead
- The Citadel
- The Micás
- Pyramid of the Sun
- Pyramid of the Moon
- Temple of Flowers.



In the afternoon, we will participate in a **pre-Hispanic ceremony** with dances, where we will give thanks to the Mexica gods by offering corn and flowers. We will receive the "new fire," a symbol of peace and harmony among nations. We will dance to pre-Hispanic drums and instruments and become jaguar and eagle warriors as in ancient Aztec times.

Later, we will prepare for dinner and disco night, where you can show your best dance moves during our Latin rhythms class, learning to dance cumbia, salsa, and traditional Mexican music.

DAY 2 – QUERÉTARO (OCTOBER 31, 2026)

After breakfast, we will head to the state of Querétaro, where we will visit the magical town of Bernal, a treasure in the heart of Querétaro. Located in the Sierra Gorda region, Bernal is a Magical Town that captivates visitors at first sight. Its cobblestone

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streets, colonial houses, and picturesque atmosphere perfectly frame its main attraction: Peña de Bernal, the third-largest monolith in the world.

Walking through Bernal feels like traveling back in time. Artisan workshops showcase the textile tradition through famous wool sarapes, while local kitchens offer gorditas, enchiladas, and traditional sweets.

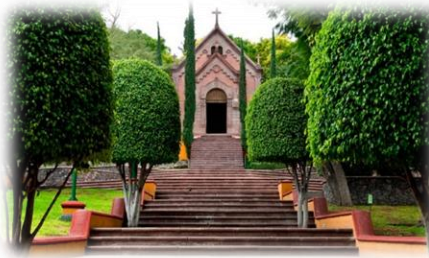
Later, we will board the **tourist tram**, to visit the most representative points of the city, its characters and its stories.

DAY 4.- SAN MIGUEL DE ALLENDE (02 NOVEMBER 2026) .

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After breakfast, we will go to the town of **San Miguel de Allende**, where we will begin a fun **rally through the city to discover the charm of this fantastic town in which we will know: The parish of San Miguel Arcángel**, which is the icon of the city with its extraordinary history of construction, when the master mason, Zeferino Gutiérrez, was commissioned to create a new façade, he was inspired for his design by drawings, engravings and postcards of European cathedrals; our tour continues at the **Casa de Allende Museum**, a two-story baroque building, it is from the eighteenth century and, with its complex stone and wrought iron work, is a magnificent example of the houses built by the wealthy Spanish nobility. **Casa del Mayorazgo de la Canal**, which is undoubtedly the most important house in San Miguel. **Ignacio Ramírez El Nigromante Cultural Center and the Angela Peralta Theater** to admire its rich facades and facilities; surrounding the center by surrounding streets, we will arrive at the **Temple of San Francisco (Ex Convento de San Antonio de Padua)**, whose façade is a challenge in the church of San Francisco. We will enjoy **San Agustín churros** in front of the temple before continuing with the tour. **Toy Museum**, where we can see toys sometimes simple, sometimes not so simple, but all of them with a common denominator: creativity.

At the end of the rally, we will have time to enjoy our food, then the delicious traditional ice creams and we will be able to buy in the craft shops before heading to the city of **San Luis Potosí**.

We will visit Tamasopo to immerse ourselves in a true **garden of water and life**, an experience that combines adventure, relaxation and direct contact with nature.

We will have lunch in the town of Tamasopo before leaving for our hotel.

DAY 6.- TAMUL WATERFALLS (NOVEMBER 04, 2026) .

After our breakfast at the hotel, we head to the town of **Tanchanchin** to paddle a wooden raft and visit the second most beautiful waterfall in our country, the **Tamul Waterfall, the jewel of the Huasteca Potosina**.

With a fall of **105 meters high**, the **Tamul Waterfall** rises majestically as the largest in the Huasteca Potosina; its turquoise blue waters descend in a natural spectacle that leaves every visitor breathless. To get there, we will sail in **traditional pangas on the Tampaón River**, surrounded by canyon walls covered with vegetation, which makes the journey an essential part of the adventure. Upon arrival in Tamul, the roar of the water and the refreshing breeze give a unique experience of contact with nature.

Back on the riverbank, we will visit the **Grotto of Eden or Water Cave**, a natural pool perfect for swimming.

To visit Tamul is to experience one of the **most impressive postcards of Mexico**, a destination that combines emotion, beauty and the natural splendor of the Huasteca.

DAY 7.- WATERFALL JUMP IN EL NARANJO (05 NOVEMBER 2026) .

After our breakfast at the hotel, we will head towards the town of **Naranjo** to visit the extraordinary **waterfall**, where we will board a raft and approach this impressive waterfall to jump into its flow; we will make some jumps from the rock to enjoy a day full of adventure.

A **dreamlike natural viewpoint** that is located in the heart of the Huasteca Potosina. This waterfall is a natural spectacle formed by a series of stepped falls that reach up to **35 meters in height**; its turquoise blue tone and the constant sound of the water create a magical atmosphere that invites contemplation and rest.

One of its great attractions is the **natural viewpoint**, from where you can see the waterfall in all its splendor, a perfect postcard for photography lovers; in addition, we will sail by wooden boat to enjoy the tranquility offered by this corner of the Huasteca, we will enjoy **unique landscapes, serenity and authentic contact with nature**.

Then we go to another extraordinary place in the Huasteca called La **Playita** where we will continue swimming in the pools.

DAY 8.- WATERFALL JUMP IN MICOS RIVER (NOVEMBER 06, 2026) .

After our breakfast at the hotel, we head towards **Rio Micos**, where we will do an extraordinary hiking activity through the riverbed. We will have the opportunity to observe the vegetation in all its splendor, swim in crystal clear water and jump in the waterfalls that form some of the most beautiful falls of the Huasteca, **Rio Micos Waterfalls, adventure, fun and adrenaline**. The **Micos River** forms one of the happiest postcards of the Huasteca Potosina: a series of **eight stepped waterfalls** ranging from small to 20-meter-high falls. Its crystal clear emerald waters invite you to swim, paddle a kayak or jump with excitement from different points, making it one of the favorite places for those looking for adrenaline and fun.

We will visit the Rio Micos Waterfalls to enjoy a place where **adventure and nature meet in perfect harmony**.

At the end, we will have time to eat regional dishes at the tourist inn of Micos, we will spend the rest of the afternoon swimming in the river, taking pictures and we will be able to buy handicrafts. At the end of our experience we will transfer to our hotel to enter the pool.
