ITINERARY

DAY 1.- SUMIDERO CANYON, CHIAPAS (FEBRUARY 13, 2027) .

We will leave on the night of **February 12** at 9:00 pm to be able to arrive at our first destination on **February 13**.

Later, we will head towards the **Sumidero Canyon Ecotourism Park**, formed 36 million years ago.

It is located in the heart of the Spider Tree in the Pyrenees, which boasts **walls of more than 1000 meters high**; in it we can see **crocodiles, birds and spider monkeys in their natural habitat**. We will board a boat in Chiapa de Corzo that will take us to the incredible visit of the Sumidero Canyon following the course of the **Grijalva River**.

On the way back from the Canyon, we will visit **Chapa de Corzo**, with its **Mudejar and Baroque style fountain** that brings together elements of Muslim art.

DAY 2.- CHIFLONS WATERFALLS (FEBRUARY 14, 2027) .

After breakfast, we will head towards the **Chiflon Waterfalls National Park**. It is one of the most impressive waterfalls in Chiapas due to its height, whose staggered fall reaches around 120 meters. The San Vicente River, one of the largest in Chiapas, is the one that gives rise to this series of waterfalls that are called: El Suspiro, Ala de Ángel and Velo de Novia, the latter the most impressive for its fall of 70 m high, it is an impressive place, where we can cool off and spend a magnificent day.

DAY 3.- LAGUNAS DE MONTEBELLO (FEBRUARY 15, 2027) .

After breakfast, we will head towards the **Montebello Lagoons**, a place of breathtaking beauty, where you can cool off. They are located within the **selva lacandona**. In this place there are more than 50 lakes that are famous for the shades of the

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different colors of their waters. We will visit the lake called **Pojoj**, one of the most beautiful because of its shades; the water is such an intense blue color that you will feel like you are in the sky itself. In this place you can swim and have a good time. If time permits, you can take a tour paddling in a **cork boat** to visit "the island", where you can see orchids and cool off in its crystal clear waters.

We will also visit the **International Lagoon**, where **we will cross the border with Guatemala** and we will rejoice to the sound of the cheerful marimba and you will be able to buy Guatemalan handicrafts.

DAY 4.- ZINACANTÁN + SAN CRISTOBAL DE LAS CASAS (FEBRUARY 16, 2027) .

After breakfast, we will head to **Zinacantán**, a Tsotsil community where **territory, language, textiles and rituals** are intertwined between **flower greenhouses**, family workshops and community spaces. The tour will allow you to understand how **local organization** and **textile trades** sustain identity and economy, and what it means to visit a living community with **intercultural respect**.

Later, we will visit the **historic center of San Cristóbal de las Casas**, a mountain city where **colonial architecture, indigenous identity and community life** are intertwined between cobblestone streets, walkways and squares. The tour will allow you to understand how **urban heritage, markets, art and traditions coexist** in a living destination, practicing **responsible tourism**.

DAY 5.- AGUA AZUL WATERFALLS, PALENQUE (FEBRUARY 17, 2027) .

After our breakfast at the hotel, we will head towards the **Agua Azul Waterfalls**, a system of **waterfalls and turquoise pools** where water, rock and jungle combine to create a landscape of great beauty. The environment allows us to understand how the **slope of the river, erosion** and **dissolved minerals** influence the formation of terraces and the color of the water, promoting a visit with a responsible **tourism approach**.

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DAY 6.- ARCHAEOLOGICAL ZONE OF PALENQUE (FEBRUARY 18, 2027).

After our breakfast at the hotel, we will head towards the **Archaeological Zone of Palenque**, a Mayan city nestled in high jungle where **architecture, water and power** are integrated into a unique landscape. Between pyramidal temples, squares and the Palace complex, the site allows us to understand how a civilization organized its political and ritual life in dialogue with the natural environment.

DAY 7.- CAMPECHE (FEBRUARY 19, 2027).

After our breakfast, we will head towards a **tram tour of the walled city of Campeche**, a panoramic and safe experience that connects **history, colonial architecture and urban life**. On board we will get to know the main landmarks of the Historic Center: squares, churches, mansions, bastions and sections of wall, understanding how the city was organized to protect itself and grow as a key port of the Gulf.

DAY 8.- HENEQUEN TOUR (FEBRUARY 20, 2027).

We will go to the **Hacienda Sotuta de Peón**, to live a henequen tour, in which we will learn about the process of making ropes by hand, extraction of henequen fiber and the process of making henequen bales. Afterwards, we will have time to swim in the **Dzul Ha cenote**.

DAY 9.- CHICHEN ITZÁ + CENOTE IK KIL (FEBRUARY 21, 2027).

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After breakfast, we will head towards **Chichen Itza** for a **guided tour** that connects **architecture, astronomy, water, and power** in one of the most iconic Mayan cities. Between **the Castle (Kukulcán)**, the **Temple of the Warriors**, the **Ball Court** and the **Sacred Cenote**, the site allows us to understand how science, ritual and social organization were integrated into daily life.

Afterwards, we will head towards the **Ik Kil cenote**, an open cenote surrounded by vegetation and vertical walls covered with lianas, where water, rock and light create a unique landscape. This environment is ideal for understanding the relationship between **karst, groundwater and Mayan culture**, and for practicing minimal-impact tourism.

DAY 10.- LAGARTOS RIVER + LAS COLORADAS (FEBRUARY 22, 2027).

After breakfast, we will head towards **Rio Lagartos** for a tour of the biosphere reserve, one of the most beautiful in this area of the peninsula. We head on the boat to **Las Coloradas**, lakes that have adopted a pink coloration due to the salinity of the water; on the way we will be able to observe animals typical of the region.
